Due to space and time constraints, we're asking that you follow a few guidelines.

## Drop-off Guidelines

### DOs

- Drop off items during school hours. Please let someone know you are dropping off a donation, so your items can be placed in a location to comply with fire codes, etc.
- Consider whether one of your family or friends would find your donation useful if you passed it on to them. Don't donate items that are dirty, broken, damaged, stained, missing pieces, etc.

### DON'Ts

- Don't pack boxes too heavy to transport.
- Don't bring in appliances that will cost the school money to dispose of if they don't sell, such as TVs, computers, computer monitors, refrigerators, air conditioners, microwave ovens, ranges/stoves, washers, dryers, freezers, dishwashers, water purifiers, or dehumidifiers.  
*(Veolia will pick-up appliances such as these from your home for a disposal fee, 359-6637.  
You may dispose of computers & monitors for a fee at Good News Project, 843-5985.)*
- Don't donate anything that can't get stored outside if temperatures get below freezing. (Parents have graciously volunteered a non-heated garage for us to use as a storage facility for items until the sale.)
