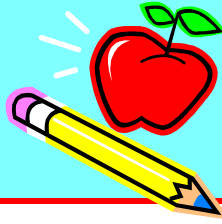

### Summer Birthdays

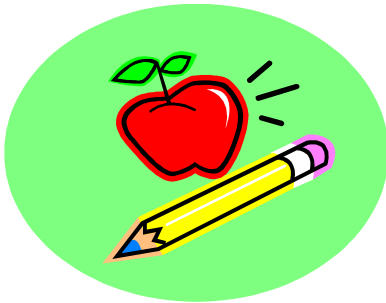
